7) Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives.

(a) Initiative: Job Fair

NCAB JOB FAIR, March 16, 2009 – Parc 55 Hotel, San Francisco, CA – 5-8 PM. Interviewed participants and gained resumes for a broad range of company positions. In attendance were General Manager, Sales, Marketing and Programming Directors and their coordinators and assistants.

(b) Initiative: Internships

Our Internship program allows students (Junior/Senior) to learn about careers in Radio. The News and Promotions Departments select interns from a large college pool for our Fall/Spring/Summer Intern sessions for School credits only.

Promotions Interns: Assist Promotions Department with sponsored events and venues around the bay area during spring and summer months. Interns assist with preparation and execution of these events as well as other promotions- related tasks, as well as update KGO/KSFO Websites.

News Interns: Get valuable hands-on experience in a fast-paced, dynamic atmosphere. KGO interns go out into the field with reporters, work with producers in the newsroom, conduct telephone and in-person interviews with newsmakers, edit audio, write copy for air, and post stories on KGORadio.com.

KGO and KSFO Marketing Coordinators manage all aspects of the Internship program, including job postings, interviewing and scheduling the Promotions Interns. The Assistant News Director and News Producers manage News Interns.

The Marketing Department's Interns are given an opportunity to chat with the Program, Sales, News, and Engineering Directors to discuss career options. Department heads (i.e. Directors) provide individual tours of their respective departments to Interns where they then learn a new skill, including board operating, call screening, sales and engineering.

(c) Initiative: Students

KGO talk show hosts, John Rothmann and Gil Gross mentor middle school, high school, and college students on careers in radio broadcasting during their shows. John Rothman's show airs on Saturday and Sunday 10 PM to 1 AM. Gill Gross' show airs Monday thru Friday 2 PM to 4 PM. Both hosts spend the first mentoring hour discussing radio and the second hour participants meet with the show producer and engineer, are given board and phone screening instruction, and remain in-studio where they interact with the hosts live and on air.

(d) Initiative: Job Banks Participation

(e) Initiative: Sponsorship of Educational/Community Events

Listener Services Coordinator KGO/KSFO or KGO Director of Marketing and Promotions, conduct a 2-hour Radio Career guided tour of the station to College and High School Students as well as selected Listeners:

Tour First Half: Attend an “interactive” News Production Meeting with our News Director, Assistant News Director, Anchors, Producers, Reporters and Intern. Q&A with all department heads: Programming, Sales, Marketing, News, and Engineering, to discuss careers in these areas of radio.

Tour Second Half: View the Gil Gross Show Live from our Green Room in which participants have access to the show producer, engineer and host. And/or watch KSFO Producer/Board Operator produce syndicated programming.
